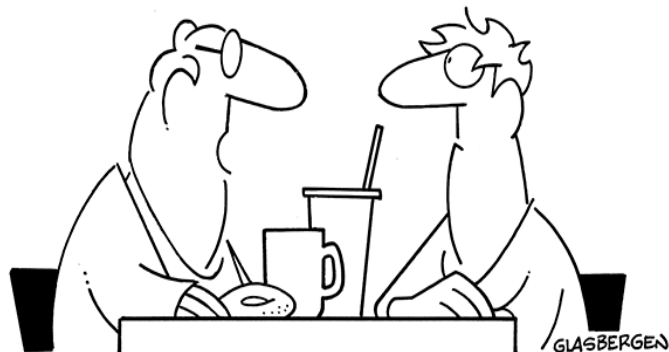
REMINDER FROM ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP COMMITTEE
